- C) Annual Sales Tax Filings. In accordance with Section 874(8) of the New York State General Municipal Law, the applicant understands and agrees that, if the Project receives any sales tax exemptions as part of the financial assistance from the Agency, the Applicant will file, or cause to be filed, with the New York State Department of Taxation and Finance, the annual form prescribed by the Department of Taxation and Finance describing the value of the sales tax exemptions claimed by the Applicant and all consultants or sub contractors retained by the Applicant.
